You might like to think about your favourite subjects, the school canteen, or perhaps after school clubs.



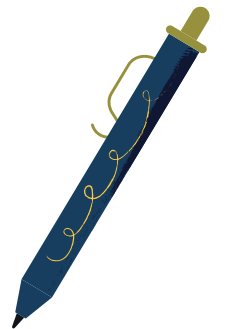
